

National Coordinating Committee (NCC) Meeting – June 04, 2026

The fourth meeting of the AML/CFT National Coordinating Committee (NCC) for 2026 was convened on June 4, 2026, at the Central Bank of Sri Lanka (CBSL), under the chairmanship of Dr. Nandalal Weerasinghe, Governor of the CBSL. The Governor emphasized the importance of collaboration and accountability from all stakeholders, urging collective action to ensure that Sri Lanka achieves a positive and credible outcome in the upcoming Mutual Evaluation (ME).



During the proceedings, Dr. Subhani Keerthiratne, Director of the Financial Intelligence Unit (FIU), delivered a presentation highlighting the country's preparedness for the ME outlining the progress, timelines and the way forward.

Adding to the discussions, Hon. Eranga Weeraratne, Deputy Minister of Digital Economy and Chairman of the Sub Committee on Virtual Asset Service Providers (VASP) presented a progress update on the work of the Sub Committee on VASP Regulatory Framework, emphasizing ongoing efforts to strengthen oversight and regulation in this rapidly evolving sector.

The meeting was attended by members of the NCC and relevant officials of the key 24 stakeholder institutions engaged in the national AML/CFT efforts, members of the AML/CFT Task Force and the Governing Board, and the senior management of the CBSL.
